



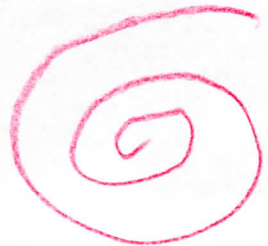

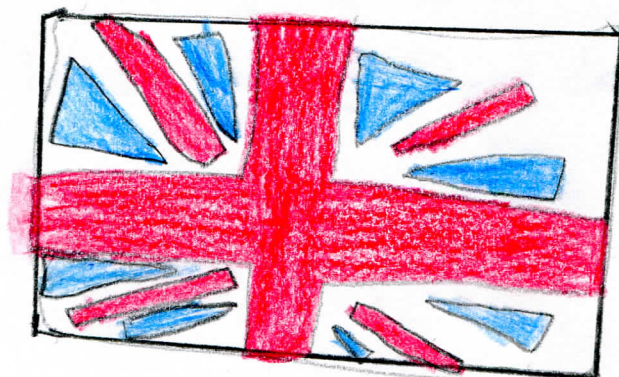

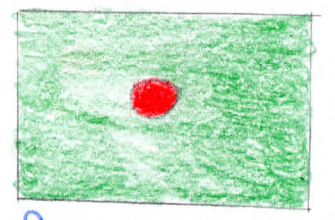
win the world cup with my team.
